**Today's trivia –** What year was the first American National Snowboard race held?

The first American National Snowboard race took place in 1982 near Woodstock, Vermont, at Suicide Six, one of the earliest ski resorts to be created. It is named so after one of the founders, Wallace Bertram, made a joke that skiing down their steepest hill, labeled "Hill Six" on their map, would be suicide. This competition proved to be one of the most important events in making snowboarding recognized as a sport.
